HOUSE BILL 2225

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 32-2811, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-2811, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 32-2811. Prohibitions and limitations; exceptions

5 A. No person may use ionizing radiation on a human being unless the
6 person is a licensed practitioner or the holder of a certificate as provided
7 in this chapter.

8 B. A person holding a certificate may use ionizing radiation on human
9 beings only for diagnostic or therapeutic purposes while operating in each
10 particular case at the direction of a licensed practitioner, EXCEPT THAT A
11 PERSON HOLDING A CERTIFICATE MAY USE IONIZING RADIATION ON HUMAN BEINGS FOR
12 DIAGNOSTIC PURPOSES ONLY WHILE OPERATING IN EACH PARTICULAR CASE AT THE
13 DIRECTION OF A LICENSED PRACTITIONER WHO IS LICENSED IN ANY OTHER STATE,
14 TERRITORY OR DISTRICT OF THE UNITED STATES. The application of ionizing
15 radiation and the direction to apply ionizing radiation are limited to those
16 persons or parts of the human body specified in the law under which the
17 practitioner is licensed. The provisions of the technologist's certificate
18 govern the extent of application of ionizing radiation.

19 C. Nothing in ~~the provisions of~~ this chapter relating to technologists
20 shall be construed to limit, enlarge or affect in any respect the practice of
21 their respective professions by duly licensed practitioners.

22 D. The requirement of a certificate shall not apply to:

23 1. A hospital resident specializing in radiology who is not a licensed
24 practitioner in this state or a student enrolled in and attending a school or
25 college of medicine, osteopathy, podiatry, dentistry, ~~naturopathy~~
26 NATUROPATHIC MEDICINE, chiropractic or radiologic technology who applies
27 ionizing radiation to a human being while under the specific direction of a
28 licensed practitioner.

29 2. A person engaged in performing the duties of a technologist in ~~such~~
30 THAT person's employment by an agency, bureau or division of the government
31 of the United States.

32 3. Dental hygienists licensed in the state of Arizona and dental
33 assistants holding a valid certificate in dental radiology from a course
34 approved by the ~~Arizona~~ state board of dental examiners.

35 4. Persons providing assistance during an ionizing radiation
36 procedure, apart from such procedures conducted in a health care institution,
37 under the direction of a person licensed for the use of an ionizing radiation
38 machine.

39 E. ~~The provisions of~~ Subsection B of this section ~~do~~ DOES not apply to
40 ionizing radiation ordered by a licensed practitioner for other than
41 diagnostic or therapeutic purposes pursuant to section 13-2505, subsection E.
