SENATE BILL 1399

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 30-105 AND 30-107, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
THE ARIZONA POWER AUTHORITY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 30-105, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 30-105. Arizona power authority commission; membership; terms
5 of office

6 A. The purposes of the authority shall be effectuated by and
7 through the Arizona power authority commission and other necessary
8 personnel. The powers and authority vested in the commission shall be
9 exercised by a majority of the members then in office.

10 B. The commission ~~shall consist~~ CONSISTS of five electors appointed
11 by the governor pursuant to section 38-211. The members shall be electors
12 qualified by administrative and business experience. ~~No~~ A member shall
13 NOT hold any other salaried public office or be associated with any public
14 service corporation engaged in generating, distributing or selling power
15 to the public generally in this state for profit, ~~nor shall any member~~
16 ~~have any interest in any business that may be adversely affected by the~~
17 ~~operation of the authority in the discharge of its duties.~~ TITLE 38,
18 CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 8 APPLIES TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION.

19 C. The term of office of each member ~~shall be~~ IS six years. The
20 terms of two members ~~shall~~ expire on the third Monday in January of each
21 odd-numbered year, except that on the third Monday in January of each
22 sixth year the term of one member ~~shall expire~~ EXPIRES. THE GOVERNOR MAY
23 REMOVE members of the commission ~~may be removed by the governor~~ for cause.

24 Sec. 2. Section 30-107, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
25 read:

26 30-107. Meetings of commission; executive session

27 A. All meetings of the commission ~~shall be~~ ARE public. All members
28 of the commission shall attend all meetings ~~thereof~~ OF THE COMMISSION
29 unless excused from attendance for a justifiable excuse, but three members
30 ~~shall~~ constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

31 B. The commission shall keep minutes of ~~its~~ THE COMMISSION'S
32 meetings ~~and may publish so much thereof as the commission considers of~~
33 ~~public interest and benefit~~ AND EXECUTIVE SESSIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH
34 SECTION 38-431.01 OR 38-431.03, AS APPROPRIATE.

35 C. THIS SECTION DOES NOT PREVENT THE COMMISSION FROM HOLDING AN
36 EXECUTIVE SESSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38-431.03.
