SENATE BILL 1139

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 28-2351 AND 28-2403, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 12, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTIONS 28-2460 AND 28-2461; AMENDING SECTIONS 28-6501, 28-6991 AND 28-6993, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2351, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-2351. License plate provided; design

5 A. The department shall provide to every owner one license plate
6 for each vehicle registered. At the request of the owner and on payment
7 of any required fee, the department shall provide either one or two
8 license plates for a vehicle for which a special plate is requested
9 pursuant to this chapter, except that the department shall provide one
10 license plate if the special plate is issued pursuant to section 28-2416
11 or 28-2416.01.

12 B. The license plate shall display the number assigned to the
13 vehicle and to the owner of the vehicle and the name of this state, which
14 may be abbreviated. The director shall coat the license plate with a
15 reflective material that is consistent with the determination of the
16 department regarding the color and design of license plates and special
17 plates. The director shall design the license plate and the letters and
18 numerals on the license plate to be of sufficient size to be plainly
19 readable during daylight from a distance of one hundred feet. In addition
20 to the standard license plate issued for a trailer before August 12, 2005,
21 the director shall issue a license plate for trailers that has a design
22 that is similar to the standard size license plate for trailers but that
23 is the same size as the license plate for motorcycles. The trailer owner
24 shall notify the department which size license plate the owner wants for
25 the trailer.

26 C. Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall not contract
27 with a nongovernmental entity to purchase or secure reflective material
28 for the plates issued by the department unless the department has made a
29 reasonable effort to secure qualified bids or proposals from as many
30 individual responsible respondents as possible.

31 D. The department shall determine the color and design of the
32 license plate. All other plates issued by the department, except the
33 plates issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412, 28-2413, 28-2414,
34 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through ~~28-2459~~ 28-2461, 28-2472, 28-2473,
35 28-2474, 28-2475 and 28-4533 and article 14 of this chapter, shall be the
36 same color as and similar in design to the license plate as determined by
37 the department.

38 E. A passenger motor vehicle rented without a driver shall receive
39 the same type of license plate as issued for a private passenger motor
40 vehicle.

41 Sec. 2. Section 28-2403, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
42 read:

43 28-2403. Special plates; transfers; violation; classification

44 A. Except as otherwise provided in this article, the department
45 shall issue or renew special plates in lieu of the regular license plates
46 pursuant to the following conditions and procedures and only if the

1 requirements prescribed by this article for the requested special plates
2 are met:

3 1. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, a person
4 who is the registered owner of a vehicle registered with the department or
5 who applies for an original or renewal registration of a vehicle may
6 submit to the department a completed application form as prescribed by the
7 department with the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for special plates
8 in addition to the registration fee prescribed by section 28-2003.

9 2. Except for plates issued pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412,
10 28-2413, 28-2414, 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through ~~28-2459~~ 28-2461,
11 28-2472, 28-2473, 28-2474 and 28-2475 and article 14 of this chapter, the
12 special plates shall be the same color as and similar to the design of the
13 regular license plates that is determined by the department.

14 3. Except as provided in section 28-2416, the department shall
15 issue special plates only to the owner or lessee of a vehicle that is
16 currently registered, including any vehicle that has a declared gross
17 weight, as defined in section 28-5431, of twenty-six thousand pounds or
18 less.

19 4. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, the
20 department shall charge the fee prescribed by section 28-2402 for each
21 annual renewal of special plates in addition to the registration fee
22 prescribed by section 28-2003.

23 B. Except as provided in sections 28-2416 and 28-2416.01, on
24 notification to the department and on payment of the transfer fee
25 prescribed by section 28-2402, a person who is issued special plates may
26 transfer the special plates to another vehicle the person owns or leases.
27 Persons who are issued special plates for hearing impaired persons
28 pursuant to section 28-2408 and international symbol of access special
29 plates pursuant to section 28-2409 are exempt from the transfer fee. If a
30 person who is issued special plates sells, trades or otherwise releases
31 ownership of the vehicle on which the plates have been displayed, the
32 person shall immediately report the transfer of the plates to the
33 department or the person shall surrender the plates to the department as
34 prescribed by the director. It is unlawful for a person to whom the
35 plates have been issued to knowingly permit them to be displayed on a
36 vehicle except the vehicle authorized by the department.

37 C. The special plates shall be affixed to the vehicle for which
38 registration is sought in lieu of the regular license plates.

39 D. A person is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor who:

40 1. Violates subsection B of this section.

41 2. Fraudulently gives false or fictitious information in the
42 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant
43 to this article.

44 3. Conceals a material fact or otherwise commits fraud in the
45 application for or renewal of special plates or placards issued pursuant
46 to this article.

1 Sec. 3. Title 28, chapter 7, article 12, Arizona Revised Statutes,
2 is amended by adding sections 28-2460 and 28-2461, to read:

3 28-2460. Collector car auction special plates; fund

4 A. IF, BY DECEMBER 31, 2017, A PERSON PAYS THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND
5 DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION, THE
6 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE COLLECTOR CAR AUCTION SPECIAL PLATES. THE PERSON
7 THAT PROVIDES THE THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS SHALL DESIGN THE COLLECTOR
8 CAR AUCTION SPECIAL PLATES. THE DESIGN AND COLOR OF THE COLLECTOR CAR
9 AUCTION SPECIAL PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE
10 DIRECTOR MAY ALLOW A REQUEST FOR COLLECTOR CAR AUCTION SPECIAL PLATES TO
11 BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES. IF THE
12 DIRECTOR ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE IN A FORM
13 PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE PERSONALIZED
14 SPECIAL PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE COLLECTOR CAR
15 AUCTION SPECIAL PLATES.

16 B. OF THE TWENTY-FIVE DOLLAR FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 28-2402 FOR
17 THE ORIGINAL SPECIAL PLATES AND FOR RENEWAL OF SPECIAL PLATES, EIGHT
18 DOLLARS IS A SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEE AND SEVENTEEN DOLLARS IS AN
19 ANNUAL DONATION.

20 C. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEPOSIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND
21 35-147, ALL SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEES IN THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND
22 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 28-6991 AND ALL DONATIONS COLLECTED PURSUANT TO
23 THIS SECTION IN THE COLLECTOR CAR AUCTION SPECIAL PLATE FUND ESTABLISHED
24 BY THIS SECTION.

25 D. THE COLLECTOR CAR AUCTION SPECIAL PLATE FUND IS ESTABLISHED
26 CONSISTING OF MONIES DEPOSITED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. THE DIRECTOR
27 SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND. THE FIRST THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS IN THE
28 FUND SHALL BE REIMBURSED TO THE PERSON THAT PAID THE IMPLEMENTATION FEE TO
29 THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION. NOT MORE THAN
30 TEN PERCENT OF MONIES DEPOSITED IN THE FUND ANNUALLY SHALL BE USED FOR THE
31 COST OF ADMINISTERING THE FUND. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE CONTINUOUSLY
32 APPROPRIATED.

33 E. THE DIRECTOR SHALL ANNUALLY ALLOCATE MONIES FROM THE FUND,
34 EXCLUDING ADMINISTRATIVE FEES, TO A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION THAT IS
35 QUALIFIED UNDER SECTION 501(c)(3) OF THE UNITED STATES INTERNAL REVENUE
36 CODE FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES AND THAT IS AFFILIATED WITH A
37 COLLECTOR CAR AUCTION COMPANY THAT MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 38 1. IS HEADQUARTERED IN THIS STATE.
- 39 2. HAS BEEN OPERATING IN THIS STATE FOR OVER TWENTY CONSECUTIVE
40 YEARS.
- 41 3. IS A PUBLIC CONSIGNMENT AUCTION DEALER AS DEFINED IN SECTION
42 28-4301.
- 43 4. AUCTIONS MORE THAN ONE THOUSAND COLLECTOR VEHICLES FOR NO
44 RESERVE EACH YEAR IN THIS STATE.

1 F. ON NOTICE FROM THE DIRECTOR, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST
2 AND DIVEST MONIES IN THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 35-313, AND MONIES
3 EARNED FROM INVESTMENT SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND.

4 28-2461. Active duty military installation support special
5 plates; fund

6 A. IF, BY DECEMBER 31, 2017, A PERSON PAYS THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND
7 DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION, THE
8 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY INSTALLATION SUPPORT SPECIAL
9 PLATES. THE PERSON THAT PROVIDES THE THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS SHALL
10 DESIGN THE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY INSTALLATION SUPPORT SPECIAL PLATES. THE
11 DESIGN AND COLOR OF THE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY INSTALLATION SUPPORT SPECIAL
12 PLATES ARE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE DIRECTOR MAY
13 ALLOW A REQUEST FOR ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY INSTALLATION SUPPORT SPECIAL
14 PLATES TO BE COMBINED WITH A REQUEST FOR PERSONALIZED SPECIAL PLATES. IF
15 THE DIRECTOR ALLOWS SUCH A COMBINATION, THE REQUEST SHALL BE IN A FORM
16 PRESCRIBED BY THE DIRECTOR AND IS SUBJECT TO THE FEES FOR THE PERSONALIZED
17 SPECIAL PLATES IN ADDITION TO THE FEES REQUIRED FOR THE ACTIVE DUTY
18 MILITARY INSTALLATION SUPPORT SPECIAL PLATES.

19 B. OF THE TWENTY-FIVE DOLLAR FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION 28-2402 FOR
20 THE ORIGINAL SPECIAL PLATES AND FOR RENEWAL OF SPECIAL PLATES, EIGHT
21 DOLLARS IS A SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEE AND SEVENTEEN DOLLARS IS AN
22 ANNUAL DONATION.

23 C. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEPOSIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND
24 35-147, ALL SPECIAL PLATE ADMINISTRATION FEES IN THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND
25 ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 28-6991 AND ALL DONATIONS COLLECTED PURSUANT TO
26 THIS SECTION IN THE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY INSTALLATION SUPPORT SPECIAL
27 PLATE FUND ESTABLISHED BY THIS SECTION.

28 D. THE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY INSTALLATION SUPPORT SPECIAL PLATE FUND
29 IS ESTABLISHED CONSISTING OF MONIES DEPOSITED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.
30 THE DIRECTOR SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND. THE FIRST THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND
31 DOLLARS IN THE FUND SHALL BE REIMBURSED TO THE PERSON THAT PAID THE
32 IMPLEMENTATION FEE TO THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS
33 SECTION. NOT MORE THAN TEN PERCENT OF MONIES DEPOSITED IN THE FUND
34 ANNUALLY SHALL BE USED FOR THE COST OF ADMINISTERING THE FUND. MONIES IN
35 THE FUND ARE CONTINUOUSLY APPROPRIATED.

36 E. THE DIRECTOR SHALL ANNUALLY ALLOCATE MONIES FROM THE FUND,
37 EXCLUDING ADMINISTRATIVE FEES, TO AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS A NONPROFIT
38 CORPORATION IN THIS STATE, THAT IS QUALIFIED UNDER SECTION 501(c)(3) OF
39 THE UNITED STATES INTERNAL REVENUE CODE FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES
40 AND THAT MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 41 1. IS HEADQUARTERED IN THIS STATE.
- 42 2. HAS BEEN OPERATING IN THIS STATE FOR OVER TEN CONSECUTIVE YEARS.
- 43 3. HAS A SOLE PURPOSE TO SUPPORT AN ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY
- 44 INSTALLATION IN THIS STATE.

1 4. PROVIDES PROGRAMS AND SERVICES FOR THE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY
2 INSTALLATION TO BENEFIT MEMBERS OF THE UNITED STATES MILITARY AND THEIR
3 FAMILIES.

4 5. PROVIDES FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO PROGRAMS AND SERVICES SUPPORTING
5 THE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY INSTALLATION. THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES MAY
6 INCLUDE SUPPORT FOR MORALE AND WELL-BEING, CULTURE AND TRADITION AND
7 MISSION SUSTAINABILITY ACTIVITIES.

8 F. ON NOTICE FROM THE DIRECTOR, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST
9 AND DIVEST MONIES IN THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 35-313, AND MONIES
10 EARNED FROM INVESTMENT SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND.

11 Sec. 4. Section 28-6501, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
12 read:

13 28-6501. Definition of highway user revenues

14 In this article, unless the context otherwise requires or except as
15 otherwise provided by statute, "highway user revenues" means all monies
16 received in this state from licenses, taxes, penalties, interest and fees
17 authorized by the following:

18 1. Chapters 2, 7, 8 and 15 of this title, except for:

19 (a) The special plate administration fees prescribed in sections
20 28-2404, 28-2412 through ~~28-2459~~ 28-2461 and 28-2514.

21 (b) The donations prescribed in sections 28-2404, 28-2412 through
22 28-2415, 28-2417 through ~~28-2459~~ 28-2461, 28-2473, 28-2474 and 28-2475.

23 2. Section 28-1177.

24 3. Chapters 10 and 11 of this title.

25 4. Chapter 16, articles 1, 2 and 4 of this title, except as
26 provided in sections 28-5926 and 28-5927.

27 Sec. 5. Section 28-6991, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
28 read:

29 28-6991. State highway fund; sources

30 A state highway fund is established that consists of:

31 1. Monies distributed from the Arizona highway user revenue fund
32 pursuant to chapter 18 of this title.

33 2. Monies appropriated by the legislature.

34 3. Monies received from donations for the construction, improvement
35 or maintenance of state highways or bridges. These monies shall be
36 credited to a special account and shall be spent only for the purpose
37 indicated by the donor.

38 4. Monies received from counties under cooperative agreements,
39 including proceeds from bond issues. The state treasurer shall deposit
40 these monies to the credit of the fund in a special account on delivery to
41 the treasurer of a concise written agreement between the department and
42 the county stating the purposes for which the monies are surrendered by
43 the county, and these monies shall be spent only as stated in the
44 agreement.

1 5. Monies received from the United States under an act of Congress
2 to provide aid for the construction of rural post roads, but monies
3 received on projects for which the monies necessary to be provided by this
4 state are wholly derived from sources mentioned in paragraphs 2 and 3 of
5 this section shall be allotted by the department and deposited by the
6 state treasurer in the special account within the fund established for
7 each project. On completion of the project, on the satisfaction and
8 discharge in full of all obligations of any kind created and on request of
9 the department, the treasurer shall transfer the unexpended balance in the
10 special account for the project into the state highway fund, and the
11 unexpended balance and any further federal aid thereafter received on
12 account of the project may be spent under the general provisions of this
13 title.

14 6. Monies in the custody of an officer or agent of this state from
15 any source that is to be used for the construction, improvement or
16 maintenance of state highways or bridges.

17 7. Monies deposited in the state general fund and arising from the
18 disposal of state personal property belonging to the department.

19 8. Receipts from the sale or disposal of any or all other property
20 held by the department and purchased with state highway monies.

21 9. Monies generated pursuant to section 28-410.

22 10. Monies distributed pursuant to section 28-5808, subsection B,
23 paragraph 2, subdivision (d).

24 11. Monies deposited pursuant to sections 28-1143, 28-2353 and
25 28-3003.

26 12. Except as provided in section 28-5101, the following monies:

27 (a) Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-2206 and section
28 28-5808, subsection B, paragraph 2, subdivision (e).

29 (b) One dollar of each registration fee and one dollar of each
30 title fee collected pursuant to section 28-2003.

31 (c) Two dollars of each late registration penalty collected by the
32 director pursuant to section 28-2162.

33 (d) The air quality compliance fee collected pursuant to section
34 49-542.

35 (e) The special plate administration fees collected pursuant to
36 sections 28-2404, 28-2412 through 28-2416, 28-2416.01, 28-2417 through
37 ~~28-2459~~ 28-2461 and 28-2514.

38 (f) Monies collected pursuant to sections 28-372, 28-2155 and
39 28-2156 if the director is the registering officer.

40 13. Monies deposited pursuant to chapter 5, article 5 of this
41 title.

42 14. Donations received pursuant to section 28-2269.

43 15. Dealer and registration monies collected pursuant to section
44 28-4304.

45 16. Abandoned vehicle administration monies deposited pursuant to
46 section 28-4804.

- 1 17. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-710, subsection D,
2 paragraph 2.
- 3 18. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-2065.
- 4 19. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-7311.
- 5 20. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-7059.
- 6 21. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-1105.
- 7 22. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-2448, subsection D.
- 8 23. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-3415.
- 9 24. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-3002, subsection A,
10 paragraph 14.
- 11 25. Monies deposited pursuant to section 28-7316.
- 12 Sec. 6. Section 28-6993, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
13 read:
- 14 28-6993. State highway fund; authorized uses
- 15 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section and section
16 28-6538, the state highway fund shall be used for any of the following
17 purposes in strict conformity with and subject to the budget as provided
18 by this section and by sections 28-6997 through 28-7003:
- 19 1. To pay salaries, wages, necessary travel expenses and other
20 expenses of officers and employees of the department and the incidental
21 office expenses, including telegraph, telephone, postal and express
22 charges and printing, stationery and advertising expenses.
- 23 2. To pay for both:
- 24 (a) Equipment, supplies, machines, tools, department offices and
25 laboratories established by the department.
- 26 (b) The construction and repair of buildings or yards of the
27 department.
- 28 3. To pay the cost of both:
- 29 (a) Engineering, construction, improvement and maintenance of state
30 highways and parts of highways forming state routes.
- 31 (b) Highways under cooperative agreements with the United States
32 that are entered into pursuant to this chapter and an act of Congress
33 providing for the construction of rural post roads.
- 34 4. To pay land damages incurred by reason of establishing, opening,
35 altering, relocating, widening or abandoning portions of a state route or
36 state highway.
- 37 5. To reimburse the department revolving account.
- 38 6. To pay premiums on authorized indemnity bonds and on
39 compensation insurance under the workers' compensation act.
- 40 7. To defray lawful expenses and costs required to administer and
41 carry out the intent, purposes and provisions of this title, including
42 repayment of obligations entered into pursuant to this title, payment of
43 interest on obligations entered into pursuant to this title, repayment of
44 loans and other financial assistance, including repayment of advances and
45 interest on advances made to the department pursuant to section 28-7677,

1 and payment of all other obligations and expenses of the board and
2 department pursuant to chapter 21 of this title.

3 8. To pay lawful bills and charges incurred by the state engineer.

4 9. To acquire, construct or improve entry roads to state parks or
5 roads within state parks.

6 10. To acquire, construct or improve entry roads to state prisons.

7 11. To pay the cost of relocating a utility facility pursuant to
8 section 28-7156.

9 12. For the purposes provided in subsections C, D and E of this
10 section and sections 28-1143, 28-2353 and 28-3003.

11 13. To pay the cost of issuing an Arizona centennial special plate
12 pursuant to section 28-2448.

13 B. For each fiscal year, the department of transportation shall
14 allocate and transfer monies in the state highway fund to the department
15 of public safety for funding a portion of highway patrol costs in eight
16 installments in each of the first eight months of a fiscal year that do
17 not exceed ten million dollars.

18 C. Subject to legislative appropriation, the department may use the
19 monies in the state highway fund as prescribed in section 28-6991,
20 paragraph 12 to carry out the duties imposed by this title for
21 registration or titling of vehicles, to operate joint title, registration
22 and driver licensing offices, to cover the administrative costs of issuing
23 the air quality compliance sticker, modifying the year validating tab and
24 issuing the windshield sticker and to cover expenses and costs in issuing
25 special plates pursuant to sections 28-2404, 28-2412 through ~~28-2459~~
26 28-2461 and 28-2514.

27 D. The department shall use monies deposited in the state highway
28 fund pursuant to chapter 5, article 5 of this title only as prescribed by
29 that article.

30 E. Monies deposited in the state highway fund pursuant to section
31 28-2269 shall be used only as prescribed by that section.

32 F. Monies deposited in the state highway fund pursuant to section
33 28-710, subsection D, paragraph 2 shall only be used for state highway
34 work zone traffic control devices.

35 G. The department may exchange monies distributed to the state
36 highway fund pursuant to section 28-6538, subsection A, paragraph 1 for
37 local government surface transportation program federal monies
38 suballocated to councils of government and metropolitan planning
39 organizations if the local government scheduled to receive the federal
40 monies concurs. An exchange of state highway fund monies pursuant to this
41 subsection shall be in an amount that is at least equal to ninety percent
42 of the federal obligation authority that exists in the project for which
43 the exchange is proposed.
