# **HOUSE BILL 2134**

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 5, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 15-158; AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 7.1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 36-894.01; AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 7.1, ARTICLE 4, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 36-897.13; AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 39, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 36-3916; RELATING TO CHILDREN.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 1, article 5, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-158, to read:

4 15-158. Use of sunscreen in schools  
5 A PUPIL WHO ATTENDS ANY PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THIS STATE MAY POSSESS AND  
6 USE A TOPICAL SUNSCREEN PRODUCT WHILE ON SCHOOL PROPERTY OR AT A  
7 SCHOOL-SPONSORED EVENT WITHOUT A NOTE OR PRESCRIPTION FROM A LICENSED  
8 HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL.

9 Sec. 2. Title 36, chapter 7.1, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
10 is amended by adding section 36-894.01, to read:

11 36-894.01. Use of sunscreen in child care facilities  
12 A SCHOOL-AGE CHILD WHO ATTENDS A CHILD CARE FACILITY IN THIS STATE  
13 MAY POSSESS AND USE A TOPICAL SUNSCREEN PRODUCT WITHOUT A NOTE OR  
14 PRESCRIPTION FROM A LICENSED HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL.

15 Sec. 3. Title 36, chapter 7.1, article 4, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
16 is amended by adding section 36-897.13, to read:

17 36-897.13. Use of sunscreen in child care group homes  
18 A SCHOOL-AGE CHILD WHO ATTENDS A CHILD CARE GROUP HOME IN THIS STATE  
19 MAY POSSESS AND USE A TOPICAL SUNSCREEN PRODUCT WITHOUT A NOTE OR  
20 PRESCRIPTION FROM A LICENSED HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL.

21 Sec. 4. Title 36, chapter 39, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
22 is amended by adding section 36-3916, to read:

23 36-3916. Use of sunscreen  
24 A CHILD WHO ATTENDS A CHILDREN'S CAMP IN THIS STATE MAY POSSESS AND  
25 USE A TOPICAL SUNSCREEN PRODUCT WITHOUT A NOTE OR PRESCRIPTION FROM A  
26 LICENSED HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL.




