**CHAPTER 280  
HOUSE BILL 2253**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 3-1207, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; APPROPRIATING MONIES;  
RELATING TO THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 3-1207, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 3-1207. Cooperation with the United States; limitations

5 A. In addition to other powers and duties conferred by law, the  
6 director may cooperate with the animal and plant health inspection service  
7 of the United States department of agriculture, or other agency of the  
8 United States vested with similar powers and duties, in:

9 1. The control of contagious or infectious diseases of animals, and  
10 contagious or infectious diseases of poultry.

11 2. The national animal identification system.

12 B. Inspectors of the animal and plant health inspection service may  
13 exercise all rights and authority granted to livestock officers, but they  
14 do not have enforcement powers granted to livestock officers.

15 C. Premises registration data, animal identification data and  
16 animal tracking data collected by the director from voluntary participants  
17 pursuant to the national animal identification system are not subject to  
18 disclosure pursuant to title 39.

19 D. THE DIRECTOR MAY NOT SUBMIT TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT ANY  
20 PREMISES REGISTRATION DATA, ANIMAL IDENTIFICATION DATA, ANIMAL TRACKING  
21 DATA, PRODUCER INFORMATION OR OTHER INFORMATION RELATING TO ANIMAL  
22 IDENTIFICATION UNLESS THE SUBMISSION IS EITHER:

23 1. REQUIRED BY STATE LAW.

24 2. AUTHORIZED BY A VOLUNTARY PARTICIPANT IN THE NATIONAL ANIMAL  
25 IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM.

26 Sec. 2. Appropriations; Arizona department of agriculture;  
27 exemption

28 A. The sum of \$217,976 and 4 FTE positions are appropriated from  
29 the state general fund in fiscal year 2017-2018 to the Arizona department  
30 of agriculture for the state veterinarian.

31 B. The sum of \$150,000 and 3 FTE positions are appropriated from  
32 the state general fund in fiscal year 2017-2018 to the Arizona department  
33 of agriculture for the plant services division.

34 C. The appropriations made in subsections A and B of this section  
35 are exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised  
36 Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations.
