AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 11-251.19; AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 11-264.07; RELATING TO COUNTY LAND ACQUISITION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 11, chapter 2, article 4, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 11-251.19, to read:
4 11-251.19. Acquisition of land; habitat conservation plan;
5 restrictions; definition
6 A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF
7 MORE THAN NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND PERSONS BUT LESS THAN ONE MILLION FIVE
8 HUNDRED THOUSAND PERSONS THAT HAS ADOPTED A HABITAT CONSERVATION PLAN MAY
9 ACQUIRE LAND THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN A CITY OR TOWN ONLY IF THE ACQUISITION
10 OF THE LAND IS PART OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY THE
11 COUNTY AND THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OR TOWN PURSUANT TO SECTION
12 11-952.
13 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO LAND THAT IS ACQUIRED BY THE
14 COUNTY FOR THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH CARE OR COURT
15 OPERATIONS.
16 C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "ACQUIRE" MEANS TO OBTAIN BY
17 PURCHASE OR ANY OTHER MEANS.
18 Sec. 2. Title 11, chapter 2, article 4, Arizona Revised Statutes,
19 is amended by adding section 11-264.07, to read:
20 11-264.07. Acquisition of land from city or town; exception
21 A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, A COUNTY MAY ACQUIRE BY PURCHASE
22 OR ANY OTHER MEANS LAND THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN A CITY OR TOWN ONLY IF
23 ACQUISITION OF THE LAND IS PART OF A MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT AGREED TO BY THE
24 GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OR TOWN.
25 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO LAND THAT IS ACQUIRED BY PURCHASE
26 OR ANY OTHER MEANS AND THAT IS FOR THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF PUBLIC SAFETY,
27 HEALTH CARE OR COURT OPERATIONS.
