**HOUSE BILL 2227**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-1104, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO  
LEGISLATIVE PER DIEM.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-1104, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 41-1104. Travel reimbursement and subsistence for members of  
5 legislature; claim required

6 A. NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 38-624, each member of the legislature  
7 shall be reimbursed for travel ~~as prescribed by law~~ AT THE FEDERAL MILEAGE  
8 REIMBURSEMENT RATE AS DETERMINED ANNUALLY BY THE UNITED STATES GENERAL  
9 SERVICES ADMINISTRATION and such reimbursement shall include travel from  
10 the temporary or permanent residence of the member to the state capitol.

11 B. Each member of the legislature shall be paid the sum of  
12 thirty-five dollars each day for subsistence during a regular or special  
13 session and the sum of thirty-five dollars each day for subsistence when a  
14 member acts on a legislative matter, other than in a regular or special  
15 session, ~~upon~~ ON the prior approval of the presiding officer of the house  
16 of which ~~he~~ THAT MEMBER is a member. Each member whose permanent  
17 residence is outside of Maricopa county shall receive an additional  
18 twenty-five dollars for each day as subsistence in a regular or special  
19 session. Each member who acts on a legislative matter, within this state  
20 in a county other than ~~his~~ THAT MEMBER'S residence, with the prior  
21 approval of the presiding officer of the house of which ~~he~~ THAT MEMBER is  
22 a member, shall be paid an additional twenty-five dollars for each day as  
23 subsistence.

24 C. Subsistence allowed to each member of the legislature during the  
25 regular session as provided in subsection B OF THIS SECTION shall be  
26 limited to the first one hundred twenty days of a regular session. After  
27 the first one hundred twenty days of a regular session, each member of the  
28 legislature shall be paid the sum of ten dollars for subsistence for each  
29 day of the regular session beyond the first one hundred twenty days. Each  
30 member whose permanent residence is outside of Maricopa county shall  
31 receive an additional ten dollars for each day beyond the first one  
32 hundred twenty days of a regular session as subsistence.

33 D. Each member of the legislature, for authorized travel out of  
34 state, shall receive travel and subsistence expenses as prescribed by law  
35 for state officers.

36 E. For payment of travel expenses and subsistence, as prescribed by  
37 the terms of this section, each member of the legislature shall submit a  
38 claim therefor countersigned by the presiding officer of the respective  
39 body.


