AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 15-538.02; RELATING TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 5, article 3, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 15-538.02, to read:

4 15-538.02. Teachers with short-term certificates; dismissal;
5 notice

6 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THE GOVERNING BOARD MAY DISMISS A
7 TEACHER WHO HOLDS A TEACHING INTERN CERTIFICATE, AN EMERGENCY TEACHING
8 CERTIFICATE OR ANOTHER TYPE OF NONSTANDARD CERTIFICATE THAT IS VALID FOR
9 ONE YEAR OR LESS WITHOUT COMPLYING WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION
10 15-537, 15-538 OR 15-541. A DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION IS
11 EFFECTIVE TEN DAYS AFTER DELIVERY OF THE NOTICE OF DISMISSAL TO THE
12 TEACHER. NOTICE OF A GOVERNING BOARD'S AUTHORITY TO DISMISS PURSUANT TO
13 THIS SECTION SHALL BE INCLUDED IN EACH TEACHER'S CONTRACT.


