CHAPTER 146

**SENATE BILL 1179**

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR A BUFFALO SOLDIERS MEMORIAL IN WESLEY BOLIN PLAZA.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Buffalo Soldiers memorial; procedures; delayed  
3 repeal

4 A. Pursuant to section 41-1363, subsection A, Arizona Revised  
5 Statutes, this act authorizes the department of administration to provide  
6 for the placement in Wesley Bolin plaza of a memorial dedicated to the  
7 commemoration of Buffalo Soldiers.

8 B. The procedures prescribed in section 41-1363, Arizona Revised  
9 Statutes, apply to the establishment of the memorial.

10 C. Public monies are not authorized for the costs of the memorial.  
11 All fund-raising and contracts for artistic design and construction of the  
12 memorial are the sole responsibility of the proponents. This state may  
13 not facilitate fund-raising or establish a state fund for the deposit of  
14 the monies.

15 D. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2021.
