CHAPTER 149

**SENATE BILL 1380**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 8-513, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 4, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 8-514.06; RELATING TO CHILD WELFARE AND PLACEMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 8-513, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 8-513. Participation in activities; contact with relatives;  
5 placement with siblings

6 A. A child may participate in activities and functions generally  
7 accepted as usual and normal for children of the child's age group if  
8 permission is granted as follows:

9 1. If the activity by law requires a license, the agency or  
10 division that placed the child may give permission on request of the  
11 foster parent.

12 2. If the activity includes the child leaving the jurisdiction of  
13 the court for a period not to exceed thirty days, the agency or division  
14 that placed the child may give permission on request of the foster parent.

15 3. If the activity is one which is associated with a school or  
16 organization not prohibited by rule of the division, the foster parents of  
17 the child may give permission.

18 B. The state shall indemnify and hold harmless the agency or foster  
19 parents for liability that may be incurred or alleged as a result of  
20 giving permission pursuant to subsection A if it is reasonably and  
21 prudently given. The state shall provide the defense of any action  
22 alleging such liability.

23 C. A child placed in foster care has the right to maintain contact  
24 with friends and ~~other~~ relatives unless the court has determined that  
25 contact is not in the child's best interests as determined pursuant to a  
26 court hearing.

27 D. If a child has been removed from the child's home and placed in  
28 out-of-home placement, guardianship or adoptive placement, the department  
29 shall make reasonable efforts to place that child with the child's  
30 siblings or, if that is not possible, to maintain frequent visitation or  
31 other ongoing contact between the child and the child's siblings unless a  
32 court determines that either the placement or the visitation or contact  
33 would be contrary to the child's or a sibling's safety or well-being.

34 E. THE OUT-OF-HOME PROVIDER FOR A YOUTH WHO IS AT LEAST SIXTEEN  
35 YEARS OF AGE SHALL WORK WITH INDEPENDENT LIVING PROGRAMS THAT ARE FOCUSED  
36 ON CAREER, EDUCATION AND FUTURE DEVELOPMENT PLANNING TO ASSIST THE YOUTH  
37 IN MEETING PROGRAM GOALS.

38 Sec. 2. Title 8, chapter 4, article 4, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
39 amended by adding section 8-514.06, to read:

40 8-514.06. Out-of-home placement; documents; definition

41 A. IF A CHILD WHO IS IN THE CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT AND WHO IS AT  
42 LEAST SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE IS PLACED IN OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT, THE  
43 OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT PROVIDER:

1           1. WITHIN SIXTY DAYS AFTER PLACEMENT, SHALL OBTAIN AND PROVIDE THE  
2 CHILD ACCESS TO THE DOCUMENTS IF THE OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT PROVIDER IS A  
3 CHILD WELFARE AGENCY.

4           2. MAY OBTAIN AND PROVIDE THE CHILD ACCESS TO THE DOCUMENTS IF THE  
5 OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT PROVIDER IS A LICENSED FOSTER HOME OR A KINSHIP  
6 FOSTER HOME.

7           B. IF AN OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT PROVIDER REQUESTS A DOCUMENT  
8 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD  
9 SAFETY VERIFIES THE CURRENT PLACEMENT, THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES  
10 OR THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, AS APPLICABLE, SHALL PROVIDE THE  
11 OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT PROVIDER WITH THE REQUESTED DOCUMENT THAT THE  
12 RELEVANT DEPARTMENT MAINTAINS.

13           C. THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES SHALL WAIVE ANY FEES CHARGED  
14 BY AN AGENCY TO PROVIDE A DOCUMENT PRESCRIBED BY SUBSECTION A OF THIS  
15 SECTION.

16           D. THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SAFETY SHALL PROVIDE A FOSTER PARENT OR  
17 KINSHIP FOSTER PARENT WITH THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF A CHILD IN THE  
18 FOSTER PARENT'S OR KINSHIP FOSTER PARENT'S CARE FOR A LAWFUL PURPOSE  
19 WITHIN NINETY DAYS AFTER THE FOSTER PARENT'S OR KINSHIP FOSTER PARENT'S  
20 REQUEST.

21           E. THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SAFETY SHALL PROVIDE A CHILD WHO IS IN  
22 ITS CUSTODY AND WHO IS AT LEAST FOURTEEN YEARS OF AGE WITH THE CHILD'S  
23 SOCIAL SECURITY CARD WITHIN ONE HUNDRED TWENTY DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF A  
24 WRITTEN REQUEST FROM THE CHILD.

25           F. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST A BIRTH CERTIFICATE FOR A CHILD WHO  
26 IS IN THE CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT AND WHO IS PLACED IN OUT-OF-HOME  
27 PLACEMENT WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE CHILD'S PLACEMENT, UNLESS THE CHILD  
28 IS RETURNED TO CUSTODY OF THE CHILD'S PARENT WITHIN THAT THIRTY-DAY  
29 PERIOD.

30           G. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "DOCUMENTS" MEANS ALL OF THE  
31 FOLLOWING:

- 32           1. THE CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE.  
33           2. THE CHILD'S NONOPERATING IDENTIFICATION LICENSE.  
34           3. THE CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORDS.
