AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 8, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 9-500.41; AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, ARIZONA
REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 11-269.20; RELATING TO HEALTH
INSURANCE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 9, chapter 4, article 8, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 9-500.41, to read:

6 A. A CITY OR TOWN MAY NOT REQUIRE AN EMPLOYER TO PROVIDE HEALTH
7 INSURANCE TO THE EMPLOYER'S EMPLOYEES.

8 B. THE REGULATION OF HEALTH INSURANCE IS OF STATEWIDE CONCERN AND
9 NOT SUBJECT TO FURTHER REGULATION BY A CITY OR TOWN.
