CHAPTER 217

SENATE BILL 1379

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 48-2607, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 48, CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE 10, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 48-2816; RELATING TO FLOOD PROTECTION DISTRICTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 48-2607, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 48-2607. District divisions; number of directors; exception

5 A. When the boundaries of the proposed district are defined and
6 established, the board of supervisors shall make an order dividing the
7 district into three or five divisions as nearly equal in size as
8 practicable, which shall be numbered consecutively. One director, who
9 shall be an elector and a resident freeholder of the division, shall be
10 elected as provided in this article by each division.

11 B. When requested in the petition, three directors, who shall be
12 resident electors and freeholders of the district, shall be elected at
13 large by the qualified electors of the district.

14 C. This section does not apply in the case of ~~the division of a~~
15 flood protection district as provided by section 48-2816.

16 Sec. 2. Title 48, chapter 18, article 10, Arizona Revised Statutes,
17 is amended by adding section 48-2816, to read:

18 48-2816. Flood protection districts; directors; qualification
19 of electors

20 A. NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 48-2682, A DISTRICT FORMED PURSUANT TO
21 THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE GOVERNED BY A BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTED AT LARGE
22 AND CONSISTING OF EITHER THREE OR FIVE DIRECTORS. ANY PERSON WHO IS
23 ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN AN ELECTION IN THE DISTRICT AS PRESCRIBED BY
24 SUBSECTION B OF THIS SECTION IS ELIGIBLE TO SERVE AS A DIRECTOR OF THE
25 DISTRICT.

26 B. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN A DISTRICT ELECTION, A PERSON MUST BE
27 AN OWNER OF REAL PROPERTY THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE
28 DISTRICT AND ON WHICH ALL TAXES HAVE BEEN PAID AS SHOWN BY THE COUNTY TAX
29 ROLL IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF THE ELECTION. IN ADDITION, THE
30 FOLLOWING APPLY:

31 1. FOR THE PURPOSE OF ORGANIZING A NEW FLOOD PROTECTION DISTRICT
32 AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTORS
33 ARE THE SAME AS PROVIDED BY THIS SECTION.

34 2. THE ADMINISTRATOR OR EXECUTOR OF THE ESTATE OF A DECEASED
35 PERSON, AND THE GUARDIAN OF A MINOR OR INCOMPETENT PERSON WHO IS APPOINTED
36 AND QUALIFIED UNDER THE LAWS OF THIS STATE, MAY REGISTER AND CAST THE VOTE
37 OF THE ESTATE OR PERSON REPRESENTED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR OR EXECUTOR.

38 3. THE OFFICER OR AGENT OF A CORPORATION IN WHOSE NAME TITLE TO
39 PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT ON WHICH IT HAS PAID TAXES AS SHOWN ON THE MOST
40 RECENT TAX ROLL AND WHO IS DESIGNATED AND AUTHORIZED BY A RESOLUTION OF
41 THE CORPORATE BOARD OF DIRECTORS IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE AND MAY REGISTER AND
42 CAST THE VOTE OF THE CORPORATION.

43 4. THE GENERAL PARTNER OF A PARTNERSHIP IN WHOSE NAME TITLE TO
44 PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT ON WHICH IT HAS PAID TAXES AS SHOWN ON THE MOST
45 RECENT TAX ROLL AND WHO IS DESIGNATED AND AUTHORIZED IN WRITING BY ALL OF

1 THE GENERAL PARTNERS IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE AND MAY REGISTER AND CAST THE
2 VOTE OF THE PARTNERSHIP.

3 5. THE TRUSTEE OF A TRUST, OR IF THERE IS MORE THAN ONE TRUSTEE, A
4 TRUSTEE WHO IS DESIGNATED AND AUTHORIZED IN WRITING BY ALL OF THE
5 TRUSTEES, IN WHOSE NAME TITLE TO PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT ON WHICH IT HAS
6 PAID TAXES AS SHOWN ON THE MOST RECENT TAX ROLL IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE AND
7 MAY REGISTER AND CAST THE VOTE OF THE TRUST.

8 6. THE MEMBER OR MANAGER OF A LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY WHO IS
9 DESIGNATED AND AUTHORIZED IN WRITING BY THE CONTROLLING MEMBERS OR
10 MANAGERS OF THE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY IN WHOSE NAME TITLE TO PROPERTY
11 IN THE DISTRICT ON WHICH IT HAS PAID TAXES AS SHOWN ON THE MOST RECENT TAX
12 ROLL IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE AND MAY REGISTER AND CAST THE VOTE OF THE LIMITED
13 LIABILITY COMPANY.

14 Sec. 3. Emergency

15 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
16 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
17 law.
