

CHAPTER 60

HOUSE BILL 2005

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 40-425, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 40-425, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 40-425. Penalty for violations not otherwise provided for;
5 separate and continuing offenses; responsibility of
6 corporation for acts of officers, agents or
7 employees

8 A. Any public service corporation ~~which~~ THAT violates or fails to
9 comply with ~~any provision of~~ the constitution or ~~of~~ this chapter, or
10 ~~which~~ THAT fails or neglects to obey or comply with any order, rule or
11 requirement of the commission, the penalty for which is not otherwise
12 provided, is subject to a penalty of not less than one hundred nor more
13 than five thousand dollars for each offense.

14 B. Each violation is a separate offense, but violations continuing
15 from day to day are one offense.

16 C. In enforcing penalties the act or omission of any officer, agent
17 or employee of a public service corporation, acting within the scope of
18 ~~his~~ THE PERSON'S duties or employment is the act, omission or failure of
19 such corporation.

20 D. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION IN THIS CHAPTER, THE
21 EXCLUSIVE REMEDY OR PENALTY FOR ANY ALLEGED OR ACTUAL VIOLATION BY A
22 PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION, OR ANY ALLEGED OR ACTUAL VIOLATION BY OR
23 PROCURED BY A PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION'S OFFICER, AGENT OR EMPLOYEE, OF
24 ANY CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISION OR ANY COMMISSION RULE BASED ON ANY
25 CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISION SPECIFYING OR RELATING TO THE TYPE OF ELECTRIC
26 GENERATION RESOURCES A PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION MUST ACQUIRE OR USE IS
27 CIVIL AND LIMITED TO THE PENALTIES SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION.






