CHAPTER 75
HOUSE BILL 2034

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 38-701, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SOCIAL SECURITY.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 38-701, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 38-701. Definitions

5 In this article, unless the context otherwise requires:

6 1. "Commissioner of social security" includes any individual to
7 whom the commissioner of social security has delegated any of the
8 commissioner's functions under the social security act with respect to
9 coverage under the act of employees of states and their political
10 subdivisions.

11 2. "Employee" means any person in the employ of this state or a
12 political subdivision of this state and includes an elective or appointive
13 officer of this state or an eligible political subdivision of this state.

14 3. "Employment" means any service performed by an employee in the
15 employ of this state or a political subdivision of this state, for the
16 employer, except service that in the absence of an agreement entered into
17 under this article would constitute "employment" as defined in the social
18 security act, or service that under the social security act may not be
19 included in an agreement between this state and the commissioner of social
20 security entered into under this article.

21 4. "Political subdivision" includes counties, incorporated cities
22 or towns and school districts in this state, and any other political
23 subdivision as defined in article XIII, section 7, Constitution of
24 Arizona.

25 5. "Social security act" means the federal social security act (42
26 United States Code chapter 7), including regulations and requirements
27 issued pursuant to that act.

28 6. "State agency" means the ~~Arizona state retirement system board~~
29 ~~established pursuant to section 38-713~~ STATE AGENCY THAT IS DESIGNATED BY
30 THE GOVERNOR TO SERVE AS THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATOR FOR THIS STATE
31 UNDER THE FEDERAL OLD AGE AND SURVIVORS INSURANCE SYSTEM.

32 Sec. 2. Retention of rules

33 All rules adopted by the Arizona state retirement system board
34 pursuant to section 38-704, Arizona Revised Statutes, remain in full force
35 until amended by the state agency that is designated by the governor to
36 serve as the social security administrator for this state.
