AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 21.1, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 36-2247; RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:


2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 21.1, article 2, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 36-2247, to read:

4 36-2247. Certificates of necessity; ambulance services; name
5 change

6 AT LEAST THIRTY DAYS BEFORE THE DATE AN AMBULANCE SERVICE CHANGES
7 ITS LEGAL NAME, THE AMBULANCE SERVICE SHALL SEND THE DEPARTMENT WRITTEN
8 NOTICE OF THE NAME CHANGE. WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF RECEIVING
9 THE NOTICE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE AN AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF NECESSITY
10 THAT INCORPORATES THE NAME CHANGE BUT RETAINS THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE
11 CURRENT CERTIFICATE OF NECESSITY.
