CHAPTER 123
HOUSE BILL 2183

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR A FRANCES WILLARD MUNDS ARIZONA WOMEN SUFFRAGE MEMORIAL IN
WESLEY BOLIN PLAZA.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Frances Willard Munds Arizona Women Suffrage
3 memorial; procedures; delayed repeal

4 A. Pursuant to section 41-1363, subsection A, Arizona Revised
5 Statutes, this act authorizes the department of administration to provide
6 for the placement in Wesley Bolin plaza of a memorial dedicated to the
7 commemoration of Frances Willard Munds, leader of the Arizona equal
8 suffrage association.

9 B. The procedures prescribed in section 41-1363, Arizona Revised
10 Statutes, apply to the establishment of the memorial.

11 C. Public monies are not authorized for the costs of the memorial.
12 All fund-raising and contracts for artistic design and construction of the
13 memorial are the sole responsibility of the proponents. This state may
14 not facilitate fund-raising or establish a state fund for the deposit of
15 the monies.

16 D. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2022.
