CHAPTER 126

HOUSE BILL 2061

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-1809.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
CLASSIFICATION OF STUDENTS FOR TUITION PURPOSES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-1809.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

4 15-1809.01. Tuition waiver scholarships; persons in foster
5 care; requirements; definition

6 A. The Arizona board of regents shall provide a tuition waiver
7 scholarship at any university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board
8 of regents and each community college district shall provide a tuition
9 waiver scholarship at any community college in that community college
10 district to any person who meets all of the following conditions:

11 1. Resides in this state.

12 2. Either:

13 (a) Is currently in foster care and is at least ~~sixteen~~ FOURTEEN
14 years of age.

15 (b) Was in foster care when the person was at least ~~sixteen~~
16 FOURTEEN years of age.

17 (c) Was adopted from foster care and the adoption was finalized
18 after the person attained ~~sixteen~~ FOURTEEN years of age.

19 3. Is a United States citizen or is a noncitizen who is lawfully
20 present in this country.

21 4. Has total personal assets, not including scholarships or grants
22 received by the person, that are worth less than ~~ten thousand dollars~~
23 \$10,000.

24 5. Is under twenty-three years of age.

25 6. Is accepted into or enrolled in a degree, certificate or other
26 accredited program at a university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona
27 board of regents or a community college under the jurisdiction of a
28 community college district. The person must demonstrate continuous
29 progress toward a degree or certificate to remain eligible for a tuition
30 waiver scholarship issued pursuant to this section.

31 7. Completed and submitted to the United States department of
32 education a free application for federal student aid before each year in
33 which the person receives a tuition waiver scholarship pursuant to this
34 section.

35 8. After the first academic year in which the person receives a
36 tuition waiver scholarship pursuant to this section, annually completes at
37 least thirty hours of volunteer service during the previous academic year.

38 9. Remains in good standing with the policies established by the
39 university or community college at which the person is enrolled.

40 B. A tuition waiver scholarship provided pursuant to this section
41 shall be reduced by the amount of any other federal aid scholarships or
42 public grants and any other public aid received by that person from or
43 through the university or community college at which the person is
44 enrolled, except that a tuition waiver scholarship may not be reduced by

1 the amount of federal grants received by the person from the department of
2 child safety under the Arizona education and training voucher program.

3 C. If the tuition waiver scholarship is terminated before a tuition
4 waiver scholarship recipient obtains an associate degree, a baccalaureate
5 degree or a certificate and before the recipient reaches twenty-three
6 years of age, that person shall continue to be awarded a tuition waiver
7 scholarship until the person reaches twenty-three years of age or obtains
8 a baccalaureate degree, an associate degree or a certificate, whichever
9 occurs first, if the person continues to meet the scholarship criteria
10 prescribed by this section.

11 D. For the purposes of this section, "tuition" means tuition and
12 mandatory fees charged by the university or community college.
