**CHAPTER 195**  
**SENATE BILL 1086**

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 32, CHAPTER 31, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE  
2; RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF HEALTH PROFESSIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 32, chapter 31, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
3 amended by adding article 2, to read:

4 ARTICLE 2. LICENSURE

5 32-3121. Definitions

6 IN THIS ARTICLE, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES:

7 1. "HEALTH PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD" HAS THE SAME MEANING  
8 PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 32-3201.

9 2. "TEMPORARY LICENSE" MEANS A SHORT-TERM LICENSE ISSUED TO A  
10 QUALIFIED INDIVIDUAL TO WORK IN THIS STATE ON A SHORT-TERM BASIS BY  
11 TEACHING A COURSE, SEMINAR OR CLASS, WORKING DURING THE PROCESS OF  
12 RECEIVING A FULL AND ACTIVE LICENSE, WORKING WHILE TRAVELING WITH A SPORTS  
13 OR ATHLETIC TEAM OR PROVIDING FREE SERVICES DURING A DECLARED STATE OR  
14 NATIONAL DISASTER.

15 32-3122. Rules

16 A HEALTH PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD MAY ADOPT RULES TO CARRY OUT  
17 THIS ARTICLE.

18 32-3123. Board delegation; executive director

19 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS TITLE, A HEALTH  
20 PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD MAY GRANT AUTHORITY TO THE BOARD'S EXECUTIVE  
21 DIRECTOR TO ISSUE AND APPROVE LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS, REGISTRATIONS,  
22 PRECEPTORSHIPS, REINSTATEMENTS OR WAIVERS TO AN APPLICANT OR LICENSEE WHO  
23 MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

24 1. FULFILLS ALL REQUIREMENTS OF THE APPLICABLE CHAPTER UNDER THIS  
25 TITLE FOR LICENSURE, CERTIFICATION, REGISTRATION, PRECEPTORSHIP,  
26 REINSTATEMENT OR WAIVERS.

27 2. HAS NOT HAD A LICENSE SUSPENDED OR REVOKED BY A HEALTH  
28 PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD IN THIS OR ANY OTHER JURISDICTION.

29 3. IS NOT CURRENTLY UNDER INVESTIGATION BY A HEALTH PROFESSION  
30 REGULATORY BOARD IN THIS OR ANY OTHER JURISDICTION.

31 4. HAS NOT SURRENDERED A LICENSE IN LIEU OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY  
32 A HEALTH PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD IN THIS OR ANY OTHER JURISDICTION.

33 5. HAS NOT ENGAGED IN ANY CRIMINAL OR CIVIL CONDUCT THAT COULD BE  
34 CONSIDERED UNPROFESSIONAL CONDUCT.

35 6. HAS NO DISCIPLINARY ACTION ON A LICENSE ISSUED BY A HEALTH  
36 PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD IN THIS OR ANY OTHER JURISDICTION.

37 32-3124. Temporary licensure; rules; fee; applicability

38 A. A HEALTH PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD IN THIS STATE MAY ISSUE A  
39 TEMPORARY LICENSE TO ALLOW AN APPLICANT WHO IS NOT A LICENSEE TO PRACTICE  
40 IN THIS STATE IF THE APPLICANT MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

41 1. HOLDS AN ACTIVE AND UNRESTRICTED HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSE IN A  
42 STATE, TERRITORY OR POSSESSION OF THE UNITED STATES.

43 2. HAS NEVER HAD A HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSE REVOKED OR SUSPENDED.

44 3. IS NOT THE SUBJECT OF AN UNRESOLVED COMPLAINT AGAINST THE  
45 PERSON'S HEALTH PROFESSION LICENSE.

1           4. HAS PAID ANY APPLICABLE FEES.  
2           B. THE APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE RESPECTIVE HEALTH PROFESSION  
3 REGULATORY BOARD A NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT ATTESTING THAT THE APPLICANT MEETS  
4 THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE RESPECTIVE LICENSING CHAPTER. THE APPLICANT SHALL  
5 NOTIFY THE BOARD IMMEDIATELY IF A CIRCUMSTANCE SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION A  
6 OF THIS SECTION CHANGES DURING THE APPLICATION PERIOD FOR A TEMPORARY  
7 LICENSE OR WHILE HOLDING A TEMPORARY LICENSE, AT WHICH TIME THE BOARD MAY  
8 SUSPEND, DENY OR REVOKE THE TEMPORARY LICENSE. THE BOARD MAY SUSPEND,  
9 DENY OR REVOKE A TEMPORARY LICENSE AND DENY THE APPLICATION FOR INITIAL  
10 LICENSURE IF THE APPLICANT HAS MISREPRESENTED THE ATTESTATION REQUIRED BY  
11 THIS SUBSECTION OR ANY OTHER PORTION OF THE APPLICATION PURSUANT TO THIS  
12 ARTICLE.  
13           C. A HEALTH PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD SHALL APPROVE OR DENY AN  
14 APPLICATION UNDER THIS SECTION WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER AN APPLICANT  
15 SUBMITS A COMPLETE APPLICATION.  
16           D. IF GRANTED, A TEMPORARY LICENSE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION  
17 EXPIRES THE EARLIER OF THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE DATE THE TEMPORARY LICENSE IS  
18 GRANTED OR ON APPROVAL OR DENIAL OF THE APPLICANT'S LICENSE APPLICATION  
19 SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO THE RESPECTIVE HEALTH PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD.  
20           E. FOR THE PURPOSE OF MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION A OF  
21 THIS SECTION, AN APPLICANT SHALL PROVIDE THE RESPECTIVE HEALTH PROFESSION  
22 REGULATORY BOARD THE NAME OF EACH STATE, TERRITORY OR POSSESSION OF THE  
23 UNITED STATES IN WHICH THE PERSON IS LICENSED OR HAS HELD A LICENSE, AND  
24 THE BOARD SHALL VERIFY WITH THE APPLICABLE REGULATORY BOARD THAT THE  
25 APPLICANT HOLDS AN ACTIVE AND UNRESTRICTED LICENSE AND HAS NEVER HAD A  
26 LICENSE REVOKED OR SUSPENDED OR SURRENDERED A LICENSE FOR DISCIPLINARY  
27 REASONS. THE BOARD MAY ACCEPT THE CONFIRMATION OF THIS INFORMATION FROM  
28 EACH OTHER REGULATORY BOARD VERBALLY, IN WRITING OR THROUGH THE USE OF THE  
29 OTHER REGULATORY BOARD'S WEBSITE, WHICH SHALL BE FOLLOWED BY EITHER AN  
30 ELECTRONIC OR HARD COPY OF THE VERIFICATION REQUIRED. IF THE BOARD IS  
31 UNABLE TO VERIFY THE INFORMATION WITHIN THE INITIAL THIRTY DAYS AS  
32 REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION C OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD MAY EXTEND THE TIME  
33 FRAME BY AN ADDITIONAL THIRTY DAYS TO RECEIVE THE NECESSARY VERIFICATION.  
34           F. THE TEMPORARY LICENSE MAY NOT BE RENEWED.  
35           G. A HEALTH PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD MAY NOT ISSUE MORE THAN TWO  
36 TEMPORARY LICENSES TO THE SAME APPLICANT WITHIN A CONSECUTIVE TWELVE-MONTH  
37 PERIOD.  
38           H. A HEALTH PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD MAY ESTABLISH AN  
39 APPLICATION AND FEE IN RULE FOR TEMPORARY LICENSURE UNDER THIS SECTION.  
40           I. THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A HEALTH PROFESSION REGULATORY BOARD TO  
41 THE EXTENT THAT THIS SECTION DOES NOT CONFLICT WITH THE BOARD'S CURRENT  
42 STATUTORY AUTHORITY RELATING TO TEMPORARY LICENSURE.
