HOUSE BILL 2151

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 12, CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 12-1567; AMENDING TITLE 22, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 22-247; AMENDING TITLE 22, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 22-525; RELATING TO JUSTICE COURTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 12, chapter 9, article 3, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 12-1567, to read:

4 12-1567. Satisfaction of judgment; superior court; filing
5 procedures; hearing; bond

6 A. THE PREVAILING PARTY SHALL FILE A SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT IN
7 THE SUPERIOR COURT WITHIN FORTY DAYS AFTER A JUDGMENT HAS BEEN PAID IN
8 FULL.

9 B. IF THE PREVAILING PARTY FAILS TO FILE A SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT
10 OR CANNOT BE LOCATED AFTER THE OPPOSING PARTY HAS EXERCISED DUE DILIGENCE
11 IN ATTEMPTING TO LOCATE THE PREVAILING PARTY, THE OPPOSING PARTY MAY FILE
12 A MOTION TO COMPEL SATISFACTION OF THE JUDGMENT. THE OPPOSING PARTY SHALL
13 INCLUDE AN AFFIDAVIT WITH THE MOTION TO COMPEL SATISFACTION OF THE
14 JUDGMENT THAT EVIDENCES PROOF OF PAYMENT AND, IF NECESSARY, THE DUE
15 DILIGENCE THAT WAS PERFORMED IN ATTEMPTING TO LOCATE THE PREVAILING
16 PARTY. IF THE MOTION IS GRANTED, THE JUDGMENT IS DEEMED SATISFIED.

17 C. A JUDGE MAY HOLD A HEARING ON THE MOTION TO COMPEL SATISFACTION
18 OF THE JUDGMENT.

19 D. A JUDGE MAY COMPEL THE MOVING PARTY TO POST A BOND WITH THE
20 COURT IN THE AMOUNT OF THE JUDGMENT.

22 is amended by adding section 22-247, to read:

23 22-247. Satisfaction of judgment; filing procedures; hearing;

25 A. THE PREVAILING PARTY SHALL FILE A SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT IN
26 THE JUSTICE COURT WITHIN FORTY DAYS AFTER A JUDGMENT HAS BEEN PAID IN
27 FULL.

28 B. IF THE PREVAILING PARTY FAILS TO FILE A SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT
29 OR CANNOT BE LOCATED AFTER THE OPPOSING PARTY HAS EXERCISED DUE DILIGENCE
30 IN ATTEMPTING TO LOCATE THE PREVAILING PARTY, THE OPPOSING PARTY MAY FILE
31 A MOTION TO COMPEL SATISFACTION OF THE JUDGMENT. THE OPPOSING PARTY SHALL
32 INCLUDE AN AFFIDAVIT WITH THE MOTION TO COMPEL SATISFACTION OF THE
33 JUDGMENT THAT EVIDENCES PROOF OF PAYMENT AND, IF NECESSARY, THE DUE
34 DILIGENCE THAT WAS PERFORMED IN ATTEMPTING TO LOCATE THE PREVAILING
35 PARTY. IF THE MOTION IS GRANTED, THE JUDGMENT IS DEEMED SATISFIED.

38 D. A JUSTICE OF THE PEACE MAY COMPEL THE MOVING PARTY TO POST A
39 BOND WITH THE JUSTICE COURT IN THE AMOUNT OF THE JUDGMENT.

2 is amended by adding section 22-525, to read:
3 22-525. Satisfaction of judgment; filing procedures; transfer
4 to justice court; hearing; bond
5 A. THE PREVAILING PARTY SHALL FILE A SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT IN
6 THE SMALL CLAIMS DIVISION OF THE JUSTICE COURT WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER A
7 JUDGMENT HAS BEEN PAID IN FULL.
8 B. IF THE PREVAILING PARTY FAILS TO FILE A SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT
9 OR CANNOT BE LOCATED AFTER THE OPPOSING PARTY HAS EXERCISED DUE DILIGENCE
10 IN ATTEMPTING TO LOCATE THE PREVAILING PARTY, THE OPPOSING PARTY MAY FILE
11 A MOTION TO COMPEL SATISFACTION OF THE JUDGMENT. IF THE MOTION IS
12 GRANTED, THE JUDGMENT IS DEEMED SATISFIED.
13 C. ON THE FILING OF A MOTION TO COMPEL SATISFACTION OF THE
14 JUDGMENT, THE CASE SHALL BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE SMALL CLAIMS DIVISION TO
15 THE JUSTICE COURT. A JUSTICE OF THE PEACE MAY HOLD A HEARING ON THE
16 MOTION TO COMPEL SATISFACTION OF THE JUDGMENT.
17 D. A JUSTICE OF THE PEACE MAY COMPEL THE MOVING PARTY TO POST A
18 BOND WITH THE JUSTICE COURT IN THE AMOUNT OF THE JUDGMENT.
