CHAPTER 307
SENATE BILL 1259

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 28-2232, 28-2239 AND 28-2267, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES;
RELATING TO VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2232, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-2232. International proportional registration authority;
5 rules; definition

6 A. Except as otherwise provided in this article, the registration
7 of fleet vehicles on a proportional basis without reference to or
8 application of section 28-2051, 28-2052, 28-2321, 28-2322, 28-2323 or
9 28-2324 or other statutes of this state relating to vehicle registration
10 is authorized.

11 B. Sections 28-2161, 28-2162 and 28-5724 and article 16 of this
12 chapter apply to vehicles proportionally registered pursuant to this
13 article.

14 C. This article does not require a vehicle to be proportionally
15 registered if the vehicle is otherwise registered in this state for the
16 operation in which the vehicle is engaged under section 28-2003, 28-2324,
17 28-2325 or 28-5433 or any other law prescribing vehicle registration fees.

18 D. THE DEPARTMENT MAY:

19 1. REFUSE TO ISSUE A REGISTRATION, LICENSE PLATE OR PERMIT FOR A
20 VEHICLE THAT IS LICENSED UNDER THIS CHAPTER AND THAT HAS BEEN ASSIGNED TO
21 A COMMERCIAL MOTOR CARRIER IF THE FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY
22 ADMINISTRATION PROHIBITS THE COMMERCIAL MOTOR CARRIER FROM OPERATING.

23 2. SUSPEND OR REVOKE A REGISTRATION, LICENSE PLATE OR PERMIT ISSUED
24 FOR A VEHICLE THAT IS LICENSED UNDER THIS CHAPTER AND THAT HAS BEEN
25 ASSIGNED TO A COMMERCIAL MOTOR CARRIER IF EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:

26 (a) THE FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ADMINISTRATION PROHIBITS THE
27 COMMERCIAL MOTOR CARRIER FROM OPERATING.

28 (b) THE COMMERCIAL MOTOR CARRIER KNOWINGLY ALLOWED OR REQUIRED AN
29 EMPLOYEE TO OPERATE A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF A FEDERAL
30 OUT-OF-SERVICE ORDER.

31 3. REINSTATE OR REISSUE A REGISTRATION, LICENSE PLATE OR PERMIT FOR
32 A VEHICLE THAT IS LICENSED UNDER THIS CHAPTER AND THAT IS ASSIGNED TO A
33 COMMERCIAL MOTOR CARRIER IF THE FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY
34 ADMINISTRATION ALLOWS THE COMMERCIAL MOTOR CARRIER TO RESUME OPERATING.

35 ~~D.~~ E. The director shall adopt rules necessary to administer and
36 enforce this article.

37 F. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "OUT-OF-SERVICE ORDER" HAS THE
38 SAME MEANING PRESCRIBED IN 49 CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS SECTION 390.5.

39 Sec. 2. Section 28-2239, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
40 read:

41 28-2239. Temporary proportional registrations; temporary
42 registration; fee

43 A. The department may sell temporary proportional registrations to
44 motor carriers that are registering under this article. Motor carriers
45 may use temporary proportional registrations for vehicles that are added

1 to an existing fleet, ~~or~~ in lieu of lost registrations pending receipt of
2 permanent or replacement registrations OR FOR VEHICLES THAT HAVE A FEDERAL
3 OUT-OF-SERVICE ORDER FROM A PREVIOUS OWNER ON THE DEPARTMENT'S RECORD.

4 B. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE TEMPORARY REGISTRATIONS TO MOTOR
5 CARRIERS THAT ARE BASED IN THIS STATE AND THAT ARE REGISTERED PURSUANT TO
6 THIS TITLE.

7 ~~B.~~ C. The cost of a temporary proportional registration is ~~one~~
8 ~~dollar~~ \$1, and the registration is valid for sixty days.

9 Sec. 3. Section 28-2267, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
10 read:

11 28-2267. Temporary registrations; fee

12 A. The department may sell temporary registrations to motor
13 carriers with existing fleets that are registered under SECTION 28-2232 OR
14 this article. MOTOR CARRIERS MAY USE temporary registrations ~~may be used~~
15 for vehicles that are added to an existing fleet, ~~or~~ in lieu of lost
16 registrations pending the receipt of permanent or replacement
17 registrations OR FOR VEHICLES THAT HAVE A FEDERAL OUT-OF-SERVICE ORDER
18 FROM A PREVIOUS OWNER ON THE DEPARTMENT'S RECORD.

19 B. The temporary registration fee is ~~one dollar~~ \$1. The temporary
20 registration is valid for sixty days.

21 Sec. 4. Effective date

22 This act is effective from and after August 31, 2020.
