

HOUSE CONCURRENT MEMORIAL 2003

A CONCURRENT MEMORIAL

URGING THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO CLEAN UP AND ERADICATE URANIUM AND RELATED AIR AND WATER POLLUTION IN THE STATE OF ARIZONA.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 To the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency
2 and the Arizona Attorney General:

3 Your memorialist respectfully represents:

4 Whereas, uranium and related air and water pollution typically
5 results from improperly reclaimed tailings and formerly abandoned uranium
6 mines, many from Federal contracts during the mid 20th century, within the
7 State of Arizona is detrimental to this state's economic health and the
8 physical health of its citizens, particularly those citizens who reside on
9 American Indian lands; and

10 Whereas, it is the express duty of the United States Environmental
11 Protection Agency to ensure the timely remediation of and address such
12 harmful pollution; and

13 Whereas, current, modern uranium mining practices typically do not
14 cause these types of pollution or result in onsite tailings and long term
15 stored materials.

16 Whereas, the United States and the Navajo Nation are addressing
17 abandoned uranium mines through settlement agreements, federal investment
18 and cleanup work.

19 Wherefore your memorialist, the House of Representatives of the State of
20 Arizona, the Senate concurring, prays:

21 1. That the United States Environmental Protection Agency take any
22 and all, necessary, additional steps to implement the remediation and
23 cleanup of uranium and related air and water pollution resulting from
24 improperly reclaimed former and abandoned uranium mines within this state.

25 2. That the Attorney General of the State of Arizona review and
26 consider any and all appropriate legal actions to compel remediation
27 actions and all additional appropriate additional actions by the United
28 States Environmental Protection Agency.

29 3. That the Secretary of State of the State of Arizona transmit
30 copies of this Memorial to the Administrator of the United States
31 Environmental Protection Agency, the Attorney General of the State of
32 Arizona and each Member of Congress from the State of Arizona.


