CHAPTER 13
HOUSE BILL 2096

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 32-2622 AND 32-2624, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING
TO SECURITY GUARDS.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-2622, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 32-2622. Qualifications of applicant for associate, security
5 guard or armed security guard registration
6 certificate

7 A. An applicant for an associate or a security guard registration
8 certificate issued pursuant to this article shall:

9 1. Be at least eighteen years of age.

10 2. Be a citizen or legal resident of the United States who is
11 authorized to seek employment in the United States.

12 3. Not have been convicted of any felony or currently be under
13 indictment for a felony.

14 4. Within the five years immediately preceding the application for
15 an associate, security guard or armed security guard registration
16 certificate, not have been convicted of any misdemeanor act involving:

17 (a) Personal violence or force against another person or
18 threatening to commit any act of personal violence or force against
19 another person.

20 (b) Misconduct involving a deadly weapon as provided in section
21 13-3102.

22 (c) Dishonesty or fraud.

23 (d) Arson.

24 (e) Theft.

25 (f) Domestic violence.

26 (g) A violation of title 13, chapter 34 or 34.1 or an offense that
27 has the same elements as an offense listed in title 13, chapter 34 or
28 34.1.

29 (h) Sexual misconduct.

30 5. Not be on parole, on community supervision, on work furlough, on
31 home arrest, on release on any other basis or named in an outstanding
32 arrest warrant.

33 6. Not be serving a term of probation pursuant to a conviction for
34 any act of personal violence or domestic violence, as defined in section
35 13-3601, or an offense that has the same elements as an offense listed in
36 section 13-3601.

37 7. Not be either of the following:

38 (a) Adjudicated mentally incompetent.

39 (b) Found to constitute a danger to self or others pursuant to
40 section 36-540.

41 8. Not have a disability as defined in section 41-1461, unless that
42 person is a qualified individual as defined in section 41-1461.

43 9. Not have been convicted of acting or attempting to act as an
44 associate, security guard or armed security guard without a license if a
45 license was required.

1 C. A security guard employee may not possess or carry a firearm
2 while on official duty unless the employee is currently registered as an
3 armed security guard and is authorized by the person's employer to possess
4 or carry the firearm.

5 D. A security guard, security guard training instructor or firearms
6 safety training instructor shall notify the director within fifteen
7 calendar days ~~of~~ AFTER any change in the name or residential address of
8 the security guard, security guard training instructor or firearms safety
9 training instructor.

10 E. The department shall not issue a security guard, security guard
11 training instructor or firearms safety training instructor provisional
12 certificate.
