



**Hand Count Audit Report
November 9-12, 2024**

Synopsis:

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-602(B), Pinal County conducted the hand count audit of early and election day precinct ballots for the November 5, 2024 General Election. Three election day (3) precincts were counted as well as 1% of early ballots.

The preliminary phase of the hand count began on November 6, 2024, at 12:00 p.m. with the Pinal County Democratic Party Chair and a representative of the Pinal County Republican Committee met to randomly select the precincts and races to be audited. All ballots were accounted for in the central counting location before the selection process started.

Precincts 90, 42 and 98 were selected by lot, as well as random batches from each of the five tabulators utilized during early ballot tabulation. In addition to the contest for U.S. President, U.S. Senate, Arizona Corporation Commission, Legislative District 15, Proposition 136 and 137 were chosen. All ballots were tabulated on four DS950 and one DS850 optical scanners.

Precinct Ballot Audit:


From November 9, 2024 to Tuesday, November 12, 2024, appointed political party representatives were broken into bipartisan teams with Democrats and Republicans on each board. Board 1 hand-counted the federal, state and legislative races for Precinct 90, while Board 2 counted Precinct 42 and Board 3 counted Precinct 98.

Early Ballot Audit:

More than 1% of early ballots were audited per Arizona State law. The early ballot audit consisted of 5 batches (one from each tabulator) containing an aggregate total of 2,294 ballots. As of November 4, 2024, 142,541 early ballots had been accepted and tabulated. All boards participated in the audit of early ballots.

Comments:

There were no discrepancies between the machine count and the hand count. Please find the aggregate precinct and early ballot reports attached for review.
