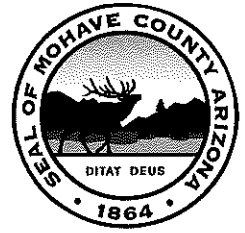

MOHAVE COUNTY Hand Count / Early Ballot Audit Report

Synopsis:

Pursuant to A.R.S. §16-248 Mohave County conducted the hand count/early ballot audit for the March 19, 2024 Presidential Preference Election. 2% of precincts were counted as required by statute, which amounted to 2 precincts out of 24 total precincts.

The hand count began on March 20, 2024 at 2 p.m. when the Mohave County Chairmen of the Republican and Democratic Parties met to select the races, precincts, and early ballot audit batches to be counted. All ballots were accounted for in the central counting location before the selection process started. The selection order was chosen by lot, and the Democrat Party was chosen to go first.

With the order established, the specific precincts to be counted were selected with the County Party Chairmen alternating the selection. Once the precincts were chosen, the race to be counted was selected.

One race was chosen according to the selection process outlined in the election's procedure manual. Specifically, the Republican Party Candidates for President of the United States was counted:


The master precinct and race selection worksheet is attached for review. The physical hand count started at 8 AM on March 23rd and was concluded at 9:30 AM that day. The tabulation method used was the stacking method. The hand count was conducted by four boards made up of 3 members each, of which not more than 2 members were from the same political party. This hand count counted votes tabulated on central count digital ballot scanners located within the Mohave County Elections Department.

Early Ballot Audit:

The 1% of early ballots as required per Arizona State Law consisted of 3 batches, each containing 100 early ballots. There were 30,818 early ballots cast in the Mohave County 2024 Presidential Preference Election.

Comments:

All hand counts came out perfect. Attached are the precinct hand count and early ballot audit results.
