

NOTICES OF FORMAL RULEMAKING ADVISORY COMMITTEES

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires the publication of Notices of Formal Rulemaking Advisory Committees whenever an agency appoints a committee before the agency submits a proposed rulemaking to the Secretary of State's Office for publication in the *Register*. Membership of the committee shall be published at the time of formation and shall be published in the *Register* annually.
