At the present time the exact date of a public hearing, if any, has not been set. However, it is anticipated that, if held, it would be in early October.
6. **A timetable for agency decisions or other action in the proceeding:**  
It is anticipated that the initial drafting and informal comment period will be completed by the middle of August. Thereafter, the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking will be filed. If there are no or insufficient requests for public hearing, the record for public comment will be closed, probably sometime in early October. Following receipt of any written comments, the package will be finalized, adopted by the Board, and filed with the Governor's Regulatory Review Council. Thereafter, the GRC has 90 days to act upon the adopted rules.
