

## NOTICES OF PROPOSED DELEGATION AGREEMENTS

The Administrative Procedure Act requires the publication of notices of proposed delegation agreements in the *Register*. A delegation agreement is an agreement between an agency and a political subdivision that authorizes the political subdivision to exercise functions, powers or duties conferred on the delegating agency by a provision of law. Delegation agreements are not intergovernmental agreements pursuant to A.R.S. Title 11, Chapter 7, Article 3. For at least 30 days after publication of the Notice of Proposed Delegation Agreement in the *Register*, the agency shall provide persons the opportunity to submit in writing statements, arguments, date, and views on the proposed delegation agreement and shall provide an opportunity for a public hearing if there is sufficient interest. The delegating agency shall follow the procedures for delegation agreements specified in A.R.S. Title 41, Chapter 6, Article 8.

6. Enforcement of regulations governing septic tank systems with subsurface disposal.
7. Approval of plans and construction of alternate, individual, on-site disposal systems with designs that conform to Engineering Bulletin 12.
8. Enforcement of regulations governing alternate, individual, on-site disposal systems with designs that conform to Engineering Bulletin 12.
9. Approval of sanitary facilities for subdivisions.
10. Enforcement of regulations governing sanitary facilities for subdivisions.
11. Compliance and construction inspections of water and sanitary facilities delegated in Appendix A.
12. Inspection, permitting, and licensing of septic tank cleaners.
13. Investigation of nuisance complaints.
14. Investigation of, and enforcement to eliminate, illegal and "wildcat" dumps.
15. Inspection and permitting of refuse haulers.
16. Inspection of private disposal operations located on property of establishments permitted or licensed by LA.
17. Approval and inspection of agricultural solid waste landfills operated by persons engaged in farming or ranching on at least 40 acres in an unincorporated area.
