The proposed amendments to R17-4-520 prescribe that no person shall be issued an Arizona driver license, allowed to maintain an Arizona driver license, or maintain out-of-state license privileges if a medical condition affects that person's ability to safely operate a motor vehicle; and establish the medical screening procedures to determine whether a person's medical condition affects that person's ability to safely operate a motor vehicle.
The proposed rule, R17-4-525, prescribes the licensing standard for persons who advise the Motor Vehicle Division that drug or alcohol use affects that person's ability to safely operate a motor vehicle and establishes licensing procedures and criteria for persons who notify the Division that drugs or alcohol affect their ability to safely operate a motor vehicle.
