NOTICES OF PUBLIC HEARINGS ON PROPOSED RULEMAKING

Notices of public hearings (oral proceedings) on proposed rulemakings will appear in this section of the *Register* whenever an agency schedules a public hearing (oral proceeding) on a proposed rulemaking after the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking has been published in the *Register*. (Hearings scheduled and listed in the Preamble of the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking appear only in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.) An agency is required to hold an oral proceeding on a proposed rulemaking if five or more people request an oral proceeding and may not be scheduled earlier than 30 days after publication of the Notice of Public Hearing on Proposed Rulemaking in the *Register*.
