These rules had set forth the minimum standards and requirements for the licensure of behavioral health service agencies but are now redundant and obsolete. Pursuant to Laws 1992, Chapter 301, § 61, and under an exemption from the provisions of A.R.S. Title 41, Chapter 6, the Department adopted new rules in Title 9, Chapter 20, Behavioral Health Service Agencies: Licensure, which govern the licensure of behavioral health service agencies. The adoption of Chapter 20 was intended to replace Chapter 10, Article 10, in its entirety; however, a repeal of Chapter 10, Article 10, was not possible under the Department's limited exemption to A.R.S. Title 41, Chapter 6. The Department is repealing these rules because they are no longer used.
