

**EXECUTIVE ORDERS, PROCLAMATIONS OF
GENERAL APPLICABILITY, AND STATEMENTS
ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR
PURSUANT TO A.R.S. § 41-1013(B)(3)**

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires the full-text publication of all Executive Orders and Proclamations of General Applicability issued by the Governor. In addition, the *Register* shall include each statement filed by the Governor in granting a commutation, pardon or reprieve, or stay or suspension of execution where a sentence of death is imposed.

PROCLAMATION

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ARIZONA

Calling a Seventh Special Session

of the Forty-fourth Legislature of the State of Arizona

By the power vested in me by Article IV, Part 2, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, I, Jane Dee Hull, Governor of the State of Arizona, call the 44th Legislature to meet in Seventh Special Session at the Capitol on Monday, the Thirteenth day of November, 2000, at 2:00 p.m.

The subject to be considered at the special session shall be:

Alternative fuel vehicles incentives and matters related thereto; appropriation of funds related thereto.
