**2. The subject matter of the proposed rule:**

The Department of Environmental Quality (Department) is proposing to adopt a rule to enable the Department and MSWLF operators to determine the population a landfill serves by dividing the amount of waste deposited in the MSWLF by an average per person per day waste disposal rate. Arizona Revised Statutes § 49-747 was enacted in 1990. It requires each landfill to pay an annual registration fee which is based on the population served by the landfill for the preceding calendar year. In 1990, when A.R.S. § 49-747 was enacted, most local governments operated their own landfills, and the population being served by each MSWLF was estimated as that jurisdiction's census population. Since then, many landfills have been sold to private companies. Consequently, the population being served by each operating MSWLF has become more difficult to determine. A landfill registration fee based on census population results in an inequity and places some landfills at a competitive disadvantage. This rule will provide a more accurate reporting of the population served by each MSWLF, and will also reflect tourist waste and out-of-state waste which is landfilled in Arizona, both of which should translate into the collection of more equitable annual registration fees from the MSWLFs in Arizona.
