

**EXECUTIVE ORDERS, PROCLAMATIONS OF
GENERAL APPLICABILITY, AND STATEMENTS
ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR
PURSUANT TO A.R.S. § 41-1013(B)(3)**

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires the full-text publication of all Executive Orders and Proclamations of General Applicability issued by the Governor. In addition, the *Register* shall include each statement filed by the Governor in granting a commutation, pardon or reprieve, or stay or suspension of execution where a sentence of death is imposed. With the exception of egregious errors, content (including spelling, grammar, and punctuation) of these orders has been reproduced as submitted.

WHEREAS, the state of Arizona recognizes that freedom is not free and that the efforts of the men and women of the Armed Services are the foundations of democracy and patriotism; and

WHEREAS, especially in Arizona, with her strong military ties and history of support for her veterans, the well-being of the veteran and their families is a priority; and

WHEREAS, through the horrors experienced during combat, the veteran is more susceptible to physical and emotional trauma. Therefore, veterans constitute approximately one-third of the population of people experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, through the highly specialized skills, strong work ethic and resolute determination learned through their military training, veterans are one of the most proficient populations when it comes to employability and rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the state is proud of all of her veterans, and is especially proud of the efforts of the local city and state communities that assist and revitalize the homeless veteran;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Janet Napolitano, Governor of the State of Arizona, do hereby proclaim November 11, 2005 as

in Arizona, and encourage all citizens to demonstrate their support for the efforts of our homeless veterans to re-enter society.
