The rulemaking will amend the language of R4-23-411 (Pharmacist-administered Adult Immunizations) to comply with the requirements of H.B. 2164. The rules will include format, style, and grammar necessary to comply with the current rules of the Secretary of State and Governor's Regulatory Review Council.
