**EXECUTIVE ORDERS, PROCLAMATIONS OF

PURSUANT TO A.R.S. § 41-1013(B)(3)**

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires the full-text publication of all Executive Orders and Proclamations of General Applicability issued by the Governor. In addition, the *Register* shall include each statement filed by the Governor in granting a commutation, pardon or reprieve, or stay or suspension of execution where a sentence of death is imposed. With the exception of egregious errors, content (including spelling, grammar, and punctuation) of these orders has been reproduced as submitted.

*** OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH ***

WHEREAS, unintentional injuries from off-highway vehicles (OHV's) are a public health concern, affecting numerous Arizona residents every year; and

WHEREAS, 1,040 Arizona children were hospitalized or seen in an Arizona emergency room for non-fatal OHV-related injuries in 2008; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that there are over 400,000 OHV's in Arizona; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, the Arizona Legislature passed Senate Bill 1167, creating new laws that help better manage Arizona's rapidly growing OHV use, while protecting natural resources; and

WHEREAS, educating our community about how unsafe and irresponsible use of OHV's affect children, families, and all community members is essential.

WHEREAS, approximately 2,600 Arizonans were diagnosed with colorectal cancer in 2008, making up nearly 1 in 8 of all new cancer cases; and

WHEREAS, the Colon Cancer Alliance – Central Arizona Chapter is a non-profit, non-partisan advocacy group working to reduce the impact of colorectal cancer in Arizona by providing current information and support to patients, survivors, supporters and caregivers, and working to promote general community awareness and education to aid in the prevention and early detection of colorectal cancer; and

WHEREAS, colorectal cancer often has no symptoms in the earliest and most beatable stages, and often does not show symptoms until the disease is in advanced stages; and

WHEREAS, cancer can be prevented or cured through early detection; and

WHEREAS, Arizona will celebrate Colon Cancer Awareness month in March with events taking place throughout the state, including activities to educate colorectal cancer patients, survivors, the medical community, and the public, and to raise awareness of colorectal cancer.

*** WOMEN AND GIRLS HIV AWARENESS DAY ***

WHEREAS, more than 44 million people are living with HIV & AIDS worldwide; and, women represent half of all people living with HIV & AIDS; and

WHEREAS, young adolescent women represent one of the highest risk groups for HIV acquisition in our country; and, young African American women residing in Arizona have demonstrated the most dramatic increases in HIV rates in the previous five years; and

WHEREAS, every 35 minutes a woman in the United States is diagnosed with HIV; and, today about one in four Americans living with HIV are female, with HIV/AIDS being the leading cause of death for African American women aged 25 to 34; and

WHEREAS, one in four HIV-positive people do not know they have HIV so Arizona through its partnerships will help to find and notify women and others of their status through the Governor's Testing Initiative, supporting a national movement to get HIV positives into care, remove stigma through education and prevention, and empower all women and others to seek the skills and resources necessary to stay negative while offering unconditional compassion to those in need.

2. Enactment of a state budget for fiscal year 2010-2011, including state employee compensation and workforce reduction.
